## PASTOR'S PARAGRAPHS

Grace and peace to you!

On July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019, I was asked the following:

"Before almighty God, to whom you must give account, and in the presence of this assembly, I ask: Will you assume this office, believing that the church's call is God's call to the ministry of word and sacrament?

The church in which you are to be ordained confesses that the holy scriptures are the word of God and are the norm of its faith and life. We accept, teach, and confess the Apostles', the Nicene, and the Athanasian Creeds. We also acknowledge the Lutheran confessions as true witnesses and faithful expositions of the holy scriptures. Will you therefore preach and teach in accordance with the holy scriptures and these creeds and confessions?

Will you be diligent in your study of the holy scriptures and faithful in your use of the means of grace? Will you pray for God's people, nourish them with the word and sacraments, and lead them by your own example in faithful service and holy living?

Will you give faithful witness in the world, that God's love may be known in all that you do?


I answered those questions: "I will, and I ask God to help me." These words were spoken the evening I was ordained. Looking back on my five years of ordained ministry, I see a very interesting journey with many ups and downs. My ministry began right before the covid pandemic, and like many church leaders, I panicked when the shutdown came in 2020 because I had no idea how I would lead two congregations. I found creative ways to have worship, like Zoom services, drive-thru communion, and drive-thru imposition of ashes on Ash Wednesday. During the pandemic, my mother passed due to complications of Covid, and we had to find new ways to have funerals. The church changed more in two years than in the last fifty.

I have served the Buffalo Valley Lutheran Parish for almost three years. Some of our beloved parishioners and community members have passed too soon. But I have seen a parish grow in their faith and love of Christ! I have seen two congregations work, laugh, and cry together. We have fed hundreds at banquets, fundraisers, and food pantries. We have celebrated baptisms and weddings and the affirmation of faith of eleven of our youth. I am excited to see where the Holy Spirit continues to guide us as a parish!

I continue to lift you all up in prayer, and if there is anything that you need, please let me know!

#### August 31 - Dandelion Run

Camp Mount Luther will be hosting a benefit 5 - and 10 - kilometer trail run race, **"The Dandelion Run"** on Saturday, August 31, 2024. This is an entry-level trail race starting at 9:00 a.m. with "day of" registration beginning at 7:30 a.m. The 10k distance is part of the 2024 Rocksylvania Trail Racing Series (Sandstone Division).

All miles for the course will be marked, and there is one water stop on the course. There will be no changing of race distance after the race starts. If you registered for the 10k and aren't sure you can finish it on race day, please change to the 5k prior to race start. 10k runners who stop after one loop will be a DNF.

The event will also feature a one-mile fun walk on a dirt road with the same registration fees and amenities. Following the race, there will be a Kids Fun Run! The age groups are 6 and under and 7 - 10. Special awards will be presented to every participant in the fun run.

<u>https://runsignup.com/Race/PA/Mifflinburg/DandelionRun5k10TrailRace.</u> The fee is \$35. You must be registered by midnight, August 11, to receive a hoodie. There will be an awards ceremony following the races. The Dandelion Run, begun in 2002, is organized by Joel and Shelley Heasley of Middleburg, assisted by Shirley Heasley of Mifflinburg. The family started the race in memory of Rev. Glenn E. Heasley, Jr., former Assistant to the Bishop of the Upper Susquehanna Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Glenn's favorite "flower" was the dandelion, because no matter what you do with them, they always rise again!




## WOMEN OF THE ELCA
