"C" the Way of Faith

A new year is upon us- a time of careful remembrances and new opportunities, a time of change and renewal. As followers of Jesus, it is a fitting time to look back to the ways we have been faithful and to also acknowledge our shortcomings. And because we are followers of Jesus, we trust in his presence and his authority to provide us with the gifts of remembrance and imagination, gifts of repentance to be able to move beyond our shortcomings and not stay stuck in the past, and by the strength of the Holy Spirit, to have the vision and purpose to again walk in the way of our Lord Jesus. 
